



Crosstown Quilters Guild Block of the Month

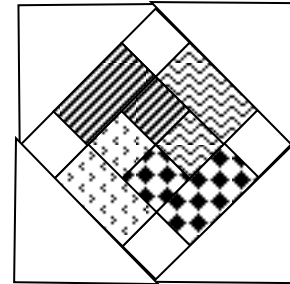
Card Trick (12.5" unfinished, 12" finished)

Fabric Requirements:

Background: white (like snow)

Cards: need 4 different fabrics, good contrast, small prints, read as solid from afar

| A 3 1/2" square | A2 3 1/4" x 6" rectangle |
| B 3 1/2" square | B2 3 1/4" x 6" rectangle |
| C 3 1/2" square | C2 3 1/4" x 6" rectangle |
| D 3 1/2" square | D2 3 1/4" x 6" rectangle |



Cut: Background:

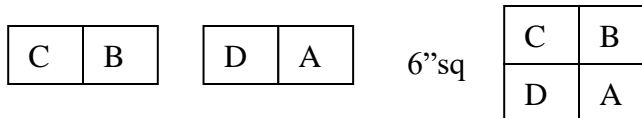
Four 3 1/4" squares (X)

Two 6" squares cut once on diagonal (X2)

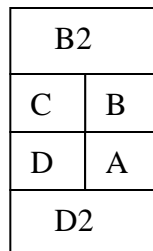
Sewing Instructions:

Make the center first.

Sew C1 to B1. Sew D1 to A1. Sew these together, nesting seams. This should measure 6" sq.

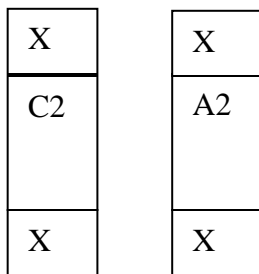


Sew B2 to top and D2 to bottom.

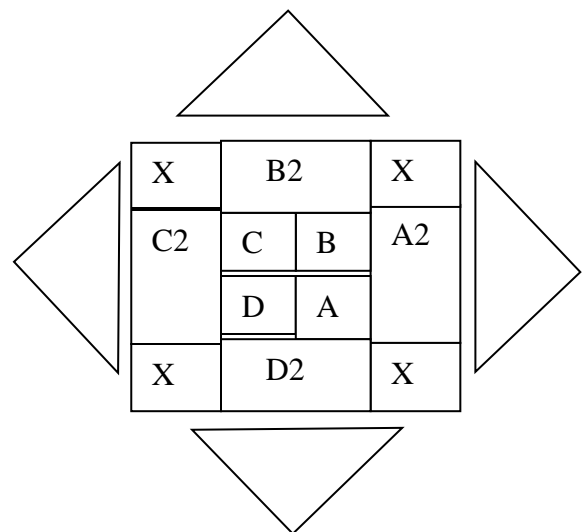


Sew background squares (X1)

To either end of C2 and A2.



Then sew these all together.



Finally, take the triangles of white background, and center and sew the long side onto each side of the square above. Then TRIM entire block to 12.5" square. Don't worry, you'll cut off a little of white background square X.
