


Crosstown Quilters Guild Block of the Month

House Block (size unfinished 12.5", finished 12")

Cutting Instructions:

sky (blue) – 2 ½" x 13", 2" x 7 ½", 2" x 5"
two 3 ½" squares
roof – 3 ½" x 12 ½"
chimney (e.g. brick, stone) - 2" x 2"
door (e.g. wood, stone) - 2 ½" x 4 ½"
window - 2 ½" x 2 ½"
house – 2 ½" x 2 ½", 2 ½" x 4 ½",
4 ½" x 4 ½", 4 ½" x 2 ½" if using directional
fabric for the house be careful to cut pieces so
that the lines are all going the same direction.
grass (green) - 2 ½" x 13" green



Assembly Instructions:

Cut and lay out all of your pieces as shown in the picture. You can swap location of the door and window on your house if you want. Use novelty fabric to depict something in the window of your house.


Sew sky fabric to both sides of the chimney.

Place the two 3 ½" squares of sky fabric right side down on both ends of the roof fabric.

Draw a line on the diagonal and sew on the diagonal. Trim away the excess and press the sky fabric out to

form the slant of the roof.

flowers or green shrubbery.



Sew the window to the small square of house fabric. Sew the piece under the window. Sew house fabric to both sides of the door and sew the door assembly to the window section. Feel free to personalize your house by sewing a piece of lace into the window for curtains, add a button for a door knob, and add flowers or shrubs under the window by using a fabric that looks like small

Sew all of the rows together to form the house. The height and width are a little over $12 \frac{1}{2}$ " so that you can sew rows together and then trim the block to $12 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $12 \frac{1}{2}$ ".
