

## **Crosstown Quilters Guild Block of the Month**

**Irish Monkey Wrench** (block size unfinished 9.5", finished 9")


**Background** – white or white on white

**Rectangles -** a nice dark green, a small print/texture works best perhaps a St Patricks Day print

Center Square—same color as background

## **Cutting Instructions:**

Background: two 4" squares one 3 ½" square (center) one strip 2" x 15" Green: Two 4 " squares One strip 2" x 15"



## **Sewing instructions:**

Place squares of background and green fabric right sides together. Draw line on diagonal. Sew a scant ¼" on either side of the diagonal line. Cut along diagonal and cut the square in half. Press flat toward the green. TRIM to 3 ½" square.











Sew the two strips of background and green fabric together. Press flat toward the green. Cut four 3 ½" by 3 ½" squares from the strip.



Assemble as shown in the diagram.
