



Crosstown Quilters Guild Block of the Month

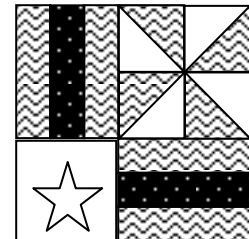
Land of Liberty (size unfinished 12.5", finished 12")

Fabric Requirements

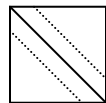
White, white on white, or white print
 Medium blue and a Medium red

Cutting Instructions:

White fabric: Three 5" squares (W)
 Red fabric: Two 5" squares (R)
 Four 2" by 8" strips
 Blue fabric: One 4" square for star
 Two 2" by 8" strips (B)



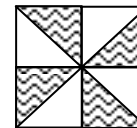
Place one 5" White square (W) and one 5" Red square (R) right sides together. Draw pencil line along the diagonal. Sew 1/4" on either side of diagonal. Cut along diagonal. Press flat. TRIM to make two 4 1/4" squares. Repeat one more time. You'll make 4 W/R half-square triangles.



Makes two



Sew the four W/R squares as shown to make a pinwheel (8" sq).

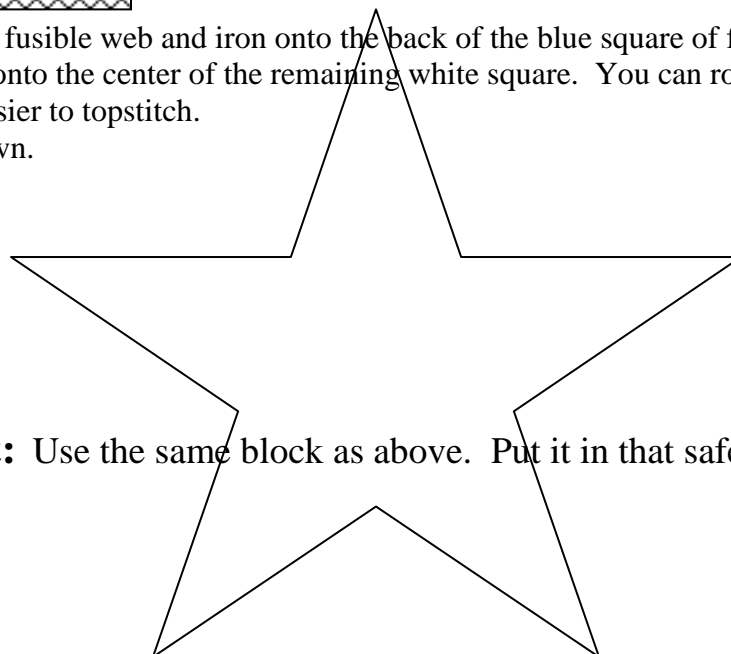


Sew two strip sets of Red-Blue-Red.



Each should measure 5" by 8".

Trace the blue star onto fusible web and iron onto the back of the blue square of fabric. After trimming the star, iron onto the center of the remaining white square. You can round the corners of the star to make it easier to topstitch.
 Assemble block as shown.



Americana Quilt: Use the same block as above. Put it in that safe spot with the other blocks.
