


Crosstown Quilters Guild Block of the Month

Pinwheel (size unfinished is 12.5", finished 12")

Background – white, or white tone on tone **Pinwheel** -- any color you see on pinwheels (solids, polka dots, stripes)




Background fabric: Four 3 ½" by 6 ½" rectangles (A)


Four 3 ½" squares (B)

Accent color fabric: Four 3 ½" squares (C)

Green, Blue, Orange, Purple, Red or any other color you have seen on a pinwheel.

Four 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " by 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles (D)






 D^{\uparrow}

Sew white rectangles (A) to each flying geese unit. These 4 units should each measure $6\frac{1}{2}$ square.

Then assemble the block as shown.



Americana Quilt: It is the same block BUT use reds and blues for the pinwheel. I call it a Patriotic Pinwheel.
