



## Crosstown Quilters Guild Block of the Month

**Pinwheel** (size unfinished is 12.5", finished 12")

**Background** – white, or white tone on tone

**Pinwheel** -- any color you see on pinwheels  
(solids, polka dots, stripes)

### Cutting Instructions:

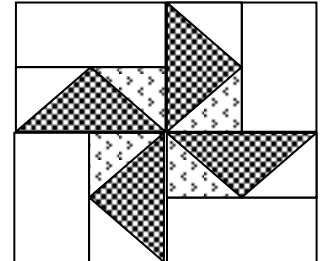
Background fabric: Four 3 1/2" by 6 1/2" rectangles (A)

Four 3 1/2" squares (B)

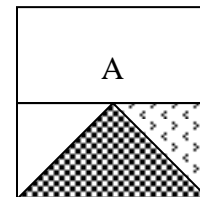
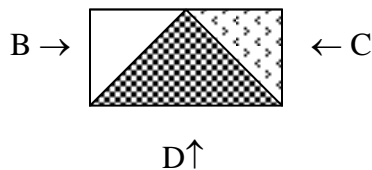
Accent color fabric: Four 3 1/2" squares (C)

Green, Blue, Orange, Purple, Red or any other color you have seen on a pinwheel.

Four 3 1/2" by 6 1/2" rectangles (D)



Using the diagram below as a guide, sew pieces together to form the flying geese unit. Place squares B with right sides together on D, sew along diagonal, trim excess fabric. Place C with right sides together on D, sew along diagonal, trim excess fabric. Press. Make 4 of these geese.



Sew white rectangles (A) to each flying geese unit.  
These 4 units should each measure 6 1/2" square.

Then assemble the block as shown.

**Americana Quilt:** It is the same block BUT  
use reds and blues for the pinwheel. I call it a Patriotic Pinwheel.
