

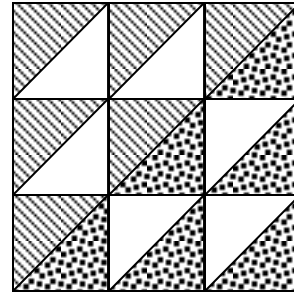


Crosstown Quilters Guild Block of the Month

Red White and Blue Triangles (size unfinished 12.5" square, finished 12")

Fabric Requirements

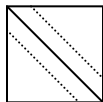
White, white on white, or light colored fabric
 Medium blue
 Medium red



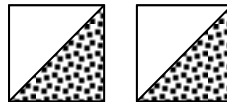
Cutting Instructions:

White fabric: Four 5" squares (W)
 Red fabric: Four 5" squares (R)
 Blue fabric: Four 5" squares (B)

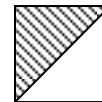
Place one 5" white square (W) and one 5" blue square (B) right sides together. Draw pencil line along the diagonal. Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " on either side of diagonal. Cut along diagonal. Press flat. **TRIM** to make two 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares. Repeat one more time. You'll make 4 W/B half-square triangles (1 extra).



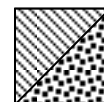
Makes two



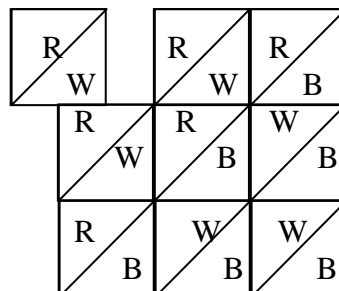
Place one 5" white square (W) and one 5" red square (R) right sides together. Draw pencil line along the diagonal. Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " on either side of diagonal. Cut along diagonal. Press flat. **TRIM** to make two 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares. Repeat one more time. You'll make 4 R/W half-square triangles (1 extra).



Place one 5" red square (R) and one 5" blue square (B) right sides together. Draw pencil line along the diagonal. Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " on either side of diagonal. Cut along diagonal. Press flat. **TRIM** to make two 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares. Repeat one more time. You'll make 4 R/B half-square triangles (1 extra).



Assemble as shown in the diagram below.



Americana Quilt: Use same block as above. Hint: use the extra half-square triangles you made above so you'll only need to make two more of each combination.
