

## **Crosstown Quilters Guild Block of the Month Road to the White House** (size unfinished 12.5", finished 12")

## **Fabric Requirements**

White, white on white, or white print Medium blue Medium red

## **Cutting Instructions:**

White fabric:	Two 5" squares (W)
	One strip $2\frac{1}{2}$ "wide, 16" long
Red fabric:	Two 5" squares (R)
Blue fabric:	Two 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares (B)
	One strip $2\frac{1}{2}$ "wide, 16" long

Place one 5" White square (W) and one 5" Red square (R) right sides together. Draw pencil line along the diagonal. Sew  $\frac{1}{4}$ " on either side of diagonal. Cut along diagonal. Press flat. **TRIM** to make two 4  $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares. Repeat one more time. You'll make 4 W/R half-square triangles.






Sew the blue and white strips together along the long side, press seam toward the dark side, trim off the end of the strip and cut six chunks that are  $2\frac{1}{2}$  "wide. Assemble two of these pieces together to make a four patch as shown below. The seams should nest in the center. These components when sewn should measure  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " square. Make three of these four-patches.



Assemble the block as shown in the diagram below.



Americana Quilt: Use the same block as above. Put it in that safe spot with the other block.
