

Crosstown Quilters Guild Block of the Month Scrappy Heart (size unfinished 8.5", finished 8")

For the monthly block raffle, make an 8 1/2 inch unfinished, 8 inch finish	ned, scrappy heart block
Use same technique as in larger scrappy heart block below to make	
the triangles X and the half-square triangles.	
Use different reds and pinks with a white background.	33333
White: two 2 ½" squares plus 8 of triangle X.	
Red/Pinks: six 2 ½" squares plus 8 of triangle X.	
Make half-square triangles first, then assemble row by row.	

Americana Themed Quilt (12.5" unfinished, 12" finished block)

Fabric Requirements

White for background. Use an assortment of blues and reds for the heart.

Cutting Instructions:

White fabric: One 8" square cut once on the diagonal (W)

Four pieces of triangle X

Red fabric: Twelve 2 ½" squares plus seven of triangle X Blue fabric: Eight 2 ½" squares plus three of triangle X

To make triangle X, take a 3" square of red or blue and cut along the diagonal. This will make two triangles (X) that are slightly larger pieces than are needed.



Assemble as shown. Make the half square triangle units first (**TRIM** to $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square) and then assemble row by row. Add large white triangles and then trim block to $12\frac{1}{2}$ " square.
