

## Christmas Stocking Pattern by Gwen Engdahl

Cut 2 lining pieces with wrong sides together

Cut 2 design front pieces (front and back) with wrong sides together

Cut 2 8-1/2" x 8-1/2" for cuff and fold each piece in half and press

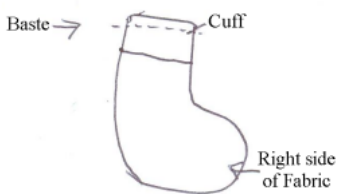
Cut 1 3' x 8" for hanging tag or use 8" grosgrain ribbon

Make Hanging Tag

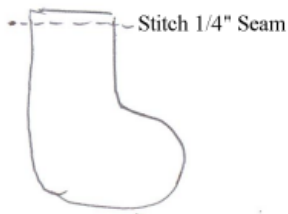
1. Fold in half lengthwise and iron
2. Open and fold over the raw edges of each long side about 1/4" in towards the center and press the edges
3. Sew together enclosing the raw edges

To make the stocking:

1. With design sides facing up, line up the folded cuff with the raw edges with the top of the stocking and baste the top edge cuff to the stocking piece. Do front and back. On the back piece of the stocking, pin or baste the hanging tag (with the raw edges up) 1" in from the side seam

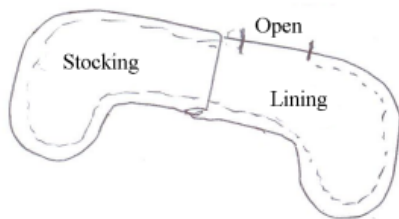


2. Layer front and back of stocking – right sides up and lining pieces of stocking on top – right sides down. Pin across top and sew with 1/4" seam allowance.



3. Open up the front and back pieces with lining attached at top. Place right sides together matching the front to the back and the lining to the lining

Double check the cuffs to make sure that they are together evenly.



4. Pin all around starting on the lining side seam leaving a wide enough opening to turn the stocking right sides out.
5. Sew a 1/2." seam all around starting at the lining and stopping at the opening.
6. Clip the rounded areas. Turn right sides out. Sew the opening closed.
7. Place the lining into the stocking and press.
